AL MADINA UNIVERSITY ARABIC CURRICULUM (*Four years program*)

Many Arabic programs have been developed in the last few years to meet the needs of Muslims who live in the west; although the effort must be praised, most of these programs yield some criticism especially when they lack a track of success when put to use. Their weakness is due to two reasons:

- Most of these programs were built on the same skeleton of those for Arabic speaking students.
- Their authors are proficient in the Arabic language but not so in the linguistics teaching methods.

The Arabic Course for English-Speaking Students as taught at the renowned Medina Islamic University, is a comprehensive course that has proven success over the years and enabled students to excel quickly -yet firmly- in the use of a combination of modern Arabic vocabulary and classical Arabic, enabling the students to familiarize themselves to every day terminology as well as that used in the Qur'an and Sunnah.

The course was developed by competent Arabic and Linguistics specialists. Their effort was crowned to produce an effective and a comprehensive four levels curriculum. The program does not only enable the students to learn how to read, write and communicate; but also it covers -in a seamless manner- all the essential Arabic grammatical rules.
