

Quizzes

Quizzes are short and rapid tests which are designed to enhance and re-enforce knowledge; and motivate students. Quizzes are not used to “nail down” student. They are used to enrich the knowledge of students.

Quizzes may be “oral” or “written”. They may take either or both formats. There is always at least one quiz per week per subject. The teacher makes at the end of each term a percentage mark of how the student did in the quizzes administered during the year.

Monthly Tests and Mid-Term and Final Examinations

There shall be at least two written tests during an academic term as follow:

- October and November for 1st Term.
- December and January for 2nd Term.
- March and April for 3rd Term.
- May and June for 4th Term.

The January test is the Mid-Term Exam. The June Test is the Final Exam.

The teacher grades these tests as percentages (100% all required questions are correct). The teacher may include optional questions to motivate students to get an extra mark. This should help student recover from past deficiency and keep the momentum up.
